'Sincerely yours' or 'Yours sincerely' ends a letter when you know the recipient or use their name. 'Yours truly' (US) or 'Yours faithfully' (UK) ends the letter when you don't know the recipient or use their name. So, if the letter starts 'to whom it may concern' or 'Dear Sir,' end the letter with 'Yours faithfully' or 'Yours truly' but not 'Sincerely yours' or 'Yours sincerely'.

If you start a letter with "Dear Sir/Madam" (or "Dear Sir or Madam" or "Dear Sirs") then you ALWAYS should end a formal letter with "Yours faithfully", sign it underneath with your name printed under your signature. You would only end a letter with "Yours sincerely" if you was addressing the letter to a specific person and knew their name (e.g.

If you do not know the name of the person you are writing to, begin with Dear Sir or Dear Sir or Madam or Dear Madam and end your letter with Yours faithfully, followed by your full name and ...
