The percentage of word-for-word citations of the Old Testament in the New Testament is about as small as the percentage of such citations from the Mosaic law in the prophets. The vast majority of the ample references in later portions of scripture to earlier portions take the form of allusions rather than citations.

Obadiah means "servant (or worshiper) of Yahweh," and it's a common biblical name—there are at least a dozen other Obadiah's in the Old Testament. Later Jewish tradition identified Obadiah as King Ahab's God-fearing steward, but that hasn't been proved (Babylonian Talmud: Sanhedrin 39b; 1 Kings 18:3-16).
